



Are you hesitating between admission to the Preparatory Year and the 1st Year entrance exam?

When you register for the 1st Year entrance exam, you can let us know that you are interested in the Preparatory Year if your application is unsuccessful, by ticking a specific box. In this case, you will not have to repeat the admission process, nor will you have to pay the registration fee again.

Admission to the Preparatory Year consists of:

- a portfolio (folder of personal works) to be uploaded to the admissions platform.
- and an on-site or remote interview.

The results for the Preparatory Year will be given on April 22, 2019.

Admission to the First Year consists of an entrance exam that takes place at a distance in two stages: eligibility and admission.

Admissibility:

This phase consists of two tests:

- a project to be created at home based on a subject given by the school
- and an art portfolio (folder of personal works).

The creative project is to be completed over one month, in February.

Based on the results of the admissibility tests, a first selection of candidates will be made.

Admission:

Candidates who have passed onto this stage will enter the admission phase, which consists of an interview, on site or at a distance, with members of the teaching team.

Results for the 1st Year will be given on April 15, 2019.
